

BAG LADIES LEAGUE RULES 2026

18 WEEK SEASON: May 5-Sept 1
Fun Night-Sept 8

1. The league shall consist of no more than 18 teams.
2. USGA rules, as amended by local rules, apply. Play will be by winter rules-ball may be moved in the fairway.
3. League fees are \$35 per person. Dues are to be paid by the first night of golf.
4. Tee times are from 4:00 to 5:30. First come, first off.
5. Due to weather conditions at Pine View at the time of league play, the Weather Committee will make a decision as to cancellation by 4:45. In the event of weather conditions changing during play, members will come in and wait 30 minutes for a possible return to play. The decision will be made by the committee and the clubhouse. In the event of lightning, golfers are to come in immediately. Members are not to call the clubhouse to check on cancellation.
6. To be eligible for the year-end individual prizes, you must play a minimum of 12 weeks. This number is reduced by 1 for every cancellation. Only regular league members are eligible. Year-end prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place teams as well as 1st low gross and 1st low individuals, and at least one blind draw. Prizes will be awarded so that individuals may not win more than one category. The Officers will determine prize amounts.
7. Play READY GOLF, not honors golf. See 'Speed of Play' sheet.
8. Turn in score cards to the Secretary after play. If you play ahead, put scorecard in the Bag Ladies envelope on the board in the Pro Shop with the league name and scheduled match date. Do not turn cards into Pro Shop desk.
9. Handicaps will be computed weekly using 80% of actual. Handicaps will be determined from the properly attested scorecards submitted by players according to USGA guidelines.
10. A 40-point scoring system based on match play will be used as follows:
 - a. A player against A player for 20 points, B player against B player for 20 points.
 - b. Two points are awarded to each player who wins a hole, one point for a tie.
 - c. Two points are awarded to the player with low net for the match or one point for a tie.
 - d. A player has the option of picking up after 10 strokes on a hole. A pickup should be indicated on the scorecard. A player who has picked up is not eligible for the 2 points for the match or for winning the event, if applicable.
 - e. Opponents must play each other. Matching of scorecards is not allowed.
11. In the event of an absent golfer, USGA rules are used. If no sub is available, the golfer plays the course and is awarded a minimum of half the points. You must play your match, even if your opponent is a no show.

12. **Make up matches need to be completed before the match date.** It is up to the team needing to reschedule to contact their opponents. **You cannot play unopposed.** Matching of scorecards is not allowed.
13. Any team that forfeits 2 times will be dropped from the league. A forfeiture is a team no show. To avoid forfeiture, each player must have a sub. If a team cannot play and/or cannot find substitutes, the opponent must be notified.
14. There will be one weekly event with a \$10 prize. Money will be divided evenly if there is more than one winner.
15. The Fun Night Committee will be selected by drawing from teams that have not done Fun Night in the past 5 years. The Fun Night Committee will receive at least \$125; more, if available.
16. The Secretary will receive \$5 per person for her services. The President and Treasurer will receive \$35 (league fees) for their services.
17. No more than 2 strokes will be given per hole; no more than 1 stroke on a par 3 hole.
